Thank you to those who supported the online virtual induction day on the 1st July. Despite the unusual circumstances, we had good participation rates. If you experienced technical difficulties on the day we have now placed recordings of all of the lessons on our website alongside the transition tasks that students will be required to complete by the start of the new term.

Your conditional offer was dependent on obtaining the entry requirements as outlined below:

- A levels: Grade 5 or above in 6 subjects including English and Maths and a grade 6 in the subject you have selected or related subject.
- Applied A Levels: Grade 4 in 4 subjects including English and Maths
- Pre-Apprenticeship programme: Attendance 95% +, Good behaviour record

On the day, you will receive an introductory talk on life in the Sixth Form College and be made aware of our expectations of you as a Sigma Sixth student. There will be the opportunity to meet the members of staff who will play a big role in your life and you will receive a tour of the new building and participate in a range of activities.

Following the DFE guidance regarding school/college opening in September we will be providing students with a supported lateral flow test. In order to make the transition a smoother one we have arranged for Sixth Form students to receive this test on **Thursday, 2nd September at Clacton County High School's testing centre, located in the gym.** Students will receive an appointment card following enrolment.

Students who attend will then be provided with home kits and will then be required to take a further LFD test on Sunday, 5th September; this is very important and your result must be recorded via www.testregister.co.uk/login and www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result.
