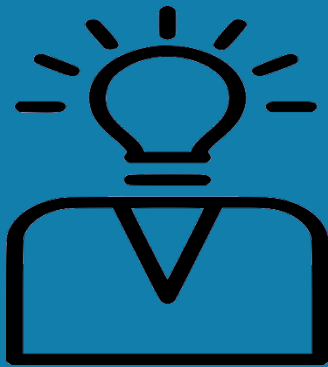


# Independent Learning Guide

You should be working for a minimum of **three-hours per week** per subject for independent work beyond what is set in lesson time.

Below is a list of suggested activities:

## For exam content you should:

Exam work is completed in the mornings. Have a folder for your exam work and keep it separate from coursework.

Focus in class on understanding the theories and ideas of the exam course – use notes and ask questions to check understanding of the Key content.

Powerpoints and videos from the lesson are placed in the shared google drive. If you forget or are not sure go over the lessons again.

Exam handouts are given at the end of a topic. Revise these by making your own notes, flashcards, mind maps or drawing out the ideas behind each topic.

Spend some time each week trying to remember the content of each topic as you will not have notes in the exam.

Use the RAG sheet to self-check what you know and to set targets for revision.

Go over your answers to exam questions to look at where you dropped marks. If you do not understand why ask your teacher to explain to you.

Retry questions you have dropped marks in. The same types of questions will come up in the exam so practice definitely will make perfect.

Make sure you understand exam questions by learning what command words mean and be familiar with the language used in the powerpoints and RAG.

Email your teacher or ask for help if you have any difficulty.

All the content you need is on the shared google drive folder for criminology – make sure you can find it easily - - one way to do this is to add it to your starred folders on google drive (right click on the folder for the option)

## For coursework content you should:
