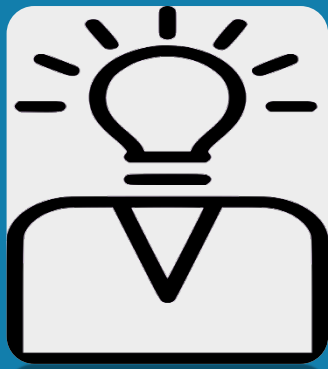


Independent Learning Guide



Performing Arts: Dance

You should be working for a minimum of **three-hours per week** per subject for independent work beyond what is set in lesson time.

Below is a list of suggested activities:

- Ensure notes are completed and filed/stored suitably in a folder or book.
- *(continue to add with subject specific tasks)*
- **After each lesson, in addition to completing any set work, a pro-active, independent learner would...**
 - Ensure that notes are completed and filed suitably in their dance folder.
 - Ensure that their dance folder is brought to every lesson.
 - Ensure that their full dance kit is brought into every practical lesson.
 - Read the relevant hand-outs and annotate lesson notes with additional, relevant content.
 - Make a list of things not fully understood and discuss with a peer or a teacher *before* the next lesson.
 - Watch performances of each professional work in full.
 - Watch live performances when available.
 - Research the next topic area before the next lesson.
 - Use the Dance Studios after college to rehearse movement material.
 - Develop techniques and skills outside of college by taking extra-curricular opportunities.
